All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices between funeral directors.

### ATTENDED FUNERAL (Funeral directors charges only)

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation	<b>£2750</b>
Taking care of all legal and administrative arrangements.	<b>£875</b>
Collecting and transporting the person who has died from the place of death (within 20 miles).	<b>£325</b>
Care of the person who has died in appropriate facilities, in an A. H. Freemantle branch of the family's choosing	<b>£350</b>
Providing a coffin suitable for cremation	<b>£375</b>
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	<b>£200</b>
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, the deceased person's coffin will be conveyed by a hearse direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises)	<b>£625</b>

### UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
A. H. Freemantle charges for a burial, not including the burial fee or plot purchase	<b>£1400</b>
A. H. Freemantle charges for a cremation inclusive of cremation fee	<b>£1500</b>

### FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the **burial fee**<sup>1</sup>

In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is: **£1171 - £1500**

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. **£865 - £2200**  
In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

For an Attended cremation funeral, the **cremation fee**<sup>2</sup> **£795 - £1300**

Please discuss any specific religious, **belief-based and/or cultural requirements** that you have with the funeral director.

### ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS & SERVICES

Additional mileage (Price per mile)	<b>£1.50</b>
Additional transfers of the deceased person (e.g. to their home, to a place of worship etc.) (Price per transfer)	<b>£250</b>
Collection and delivery of ashes outside of 10 miles	<b>POA</b>
Embalming	<b>£200</b>
Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister of religion etc.) POA but typical price	<b>£230</b>
Services supplied outside of normal office hours	<b>POA</b>

1. This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave. 2. In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
